Trees on Beech Street have been cut work should begin on Beech Street in approximately 2 weeks. 5 culverts have been put in, trucks have been dressed for winter, 1970 case tractor would like to get ride off. The letter he received last week doesn't feel he needs to be in executive session this evening for.

SUPERVISOR REPORT- Supervisor Argotsinger reported he had inquired on holding evening meetings and it would be discussed at the organizational meeting for 2012. Also stated he is on the financial committee and the tentative budget that will be going to the full board is the rate to be 12.64 up 15.2% from last year. This rate could change when the full board reviews it.

ASSESSOR REPORT- Melissa Mazzarelli Assessor submitted her monthly report which included star enhanced renewal forms will be sent out on or before November 1st.
