

## REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING SEPTEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup> 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Mayfield Town Board was held on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2020 at the Mayfield Municipal Complex, 28 N. School St. Mayfield NY 12117. The meeting was opened at 6:30 PM by Supervisor Richard Argotsinger with the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None at this time.

### DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT – Highway Superintendent Jeff Martin submitted his report stating that all Town road shoulders have been mowed twice and will not be done again unless there are complaints, tree and ditch work is done on Gray Rd. 500 Tons of sand has been brought in and the oil has been changed in the trucks. Other needed truck maintenance is also being done. 200 Tons of salt has been ordered. CHIPS paperwork is turned in and mining permit is renewed. There is a new hire for the Garbage truck. The highway department is back to 5-8 hour days. Trees over the road will be trimmed with Gloversville Waterworks bucket truck, a small chainsaw is needed. The quotes for 2 plows and a sander are in. The highway department loaned Northville a truck and hauled blacktop for Bleecker. Setting up for Fall Clean-up Days. The safe has been picked up from Northville.

SUPERVISORS REPORT – Supervisor Richard Argotsinger submitted his report stating the insurance payment for the beach will be refunded, letter received from Patricia Gardner stating there is a new mental health program available and information will be available in the vestibule. Dog and Historian reports were received. Hazardous Mitigation is having a video conference on September 15<sup>th</sup>, and it is usually attended by the CEO/BI and Highway Superintendent.

Supervisor Argotsinger received a call from Senator Tediscos office in regards to taking over Mariners Rd ext. The criteria that must be met for the Town to take over the road was explained. Lengthy discussion about a streetlight on St. Hwy 29 and Co. Hwy 158

SOUTHERN ADIRONDACK SNOWMOBILE ASSOCIATION – The contract was submitted for the S.A.S.A to use town property for the 2020-2021 snowmobile season.

STREET LIGHT ON STATE HIGHWAY 29 – Lengthy discussion about the streetlight that has been out for approximately 3 years. It is up to the State or County if another light is installed, but the Town will be responsible for the electric bill.

The planning board meets next week for 2 sub-divisions and a public hearing and there is a proposed convenience store going in at the old Russos Restaurant. Several letters of violation were sent and the clean-ups on Riceville Rd and Phelps St. are moving along. Neighbor dispute calls are frequent. Borrego Solar project is moving along and Sacandaga Brewery has received their C of O and is now open for business.
