PUBLIC- No one spoke at this time.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

CEO- Mike Stewart CEO submitted his monthly report which included 15 permits issued for the month .Town had 11,693 visits to the website. Planning Board met and approved a lot line amendment for Duane Yost. Also representatives from the county attended the meeting to discuss the strategic plan for the Vail Mills area. A subdivision request from Roger Putman on Sand Hill Rd was tabled until a test well is drilled to determine water potability.

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT- Mel Dopp, Highway Superintendent presented pictures to the board of Tolmantown Road that the town took possession of and reports that the bridge is in desperate need of repair. There are also some places that the road needs to come up approximately 3 feet. Mel feels the town needs to allocate monies for some repairs. There are approximately 89 culverts and again feels much work to do on this road. Mel asked Councilman Putman for his suggestions on this road. SupervisorArgotsinger again reported that he received a call asking if the town wanted the road or abandon it. Mayor Ward commended the board for taking over the road. A lengthy discussion followed on temporarily closing the bridge.

The fire contract scheduled public hearing was opened at 6:45pm with Mike Stewart reading the certificate of publication.

The public hearing was left open and the town continued with town business.

SUPERVISOR REPORT- Supervisor Argotsinger reported that the dog report was submitted 10 dog complaints handled and 2 dog bites for the month The 3rd quarter sales tax check was received and is up \$18,803.96 from 2015. Also the tentative 2017 county board budget is up1.8%; they will be holding a budget workshop on Monday. A computer for the cemetery was ordered and when delivered internet service was discovered to be very slow. The town has the internet contract for the building and will look into perhaps getting better internet service. Also received a call from Terry Bills

who is taking the trees down at the Riceville cemetery and reported that the trees will all be down by Friday morning.

The scheduled public hearing on the town budget that was advertised for 7:00 pm was opened and Mike Stewart read the certification of publication.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayfield Village Mayor Ward addressed the board regarding the water tower. A proposed site at the Highway Department was discussed. They would need approximately ½ acre of land for this project. Supervisor Argotsinger requested that they meet with the board and Mel Dopp Highway Superintendent to walk the property.
