The text of this Local Law is annexed hereto.

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT

The Town Board of the Town of Mayfield hereby finds and declares that it intends to provide for the public health, safety and welfare through the regulation and control of dangerous, endangered and exotic animals not otherwise regulated and controlled by Federal, State and local laws, as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

As used in this Local Law, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated, unless it is plainly evident from the context that a different meaning is intended:

(a) "Dangerous and Endangered Animals" shall mean any animal subject to the notification provisions of Section 209 -cc of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York or which is listed by New York State Department of Environmental Conservation as being dangerous or endangered;

(b) "Exotic Animal" shall mean any of the following:

(1) Following members of the Class Aves: Order Falconiformes (such as, but not limited to, hawks, eagles, and vultures which are not kept pursuant to Federal or State permit), and Subdivision Ratitae (such as, but not limited to, ostriches, rheas, cassowaries and emus);

(2) Following members of the Class Mammalia: Order Carnivora, expressly excepting the domestic dog (canis familiaris) and the domestic cat (Felis cattus) and including, but not limited to, the Family Feldae (such as ocelots, margays, lions, tigers, jaguars, leopards and cougars), the Family Canidae (such as wolves, dingos, coyotes, and jackals), and Order Marsupialis (such as kangaroos and common opossums, Didelphis marsupialia) and Order Chiroptera (bats) and Order Edentata (such as sloths, anteaters and armadillos), and Order Proboscidea (elephants) and Order Primata (including but not limited to, monkeys, chimpanzees and gorillas); or

(3) Any species of animal which is venomous to human beings whether its venom is transmitted by bite, sting, and touch or other means, except honey producing bees.

(c) "Venomous" shall mean having a gland for the secretion of venom able to inflict a poisoned bite, sting or wound.

(d) "Owner" shall mean any person, firm, corporation or other entity owning, having interest in, or having control, custody or possession of any exotic animal.

(e) "Person" shall include any person, partnership, corporation, trust, and association of persons or other entity.

(f) "Zoo" shall mean any lawfully operating business which possesses all required State and Federal Licenses to operate as such, and which exhibits dangerous, endangered or exotic animals for the purpose of viewing by the general public.

SECTION 3. RESTRICTIONS

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No person shall own, possess, keep or harbor any dangerous , endangered or exotic animal within the Town of Mayfield.

SECTION 4. EXCEPTIONS

(a) Any lawfully existing zoo in operation on the date of enactment of this Local Law shall be exempt from the provisions hereof; provided, however that any expansion or enlargement of such operation beyond the parcel on which it is currently located shall require a special use permit as set forth and outlined in the Town of Mayfield Zoning Law.

(b) Any lawfully existing exhibitor of dangerous, endangered or exotic animals in operation on the date of enactment of this Local Law, which possesses all the required State and Federal Licenses to operate as such, but is not a Zoo, shall be exempt from the provisions hereof; provided, however that any expansion or enlargement of such operation in any way shall require a special use permit as setforth and outlined in the Town of Mayfield Zoning Law.

(c) The provisions of this Local Law shall not apply to any of the following:

1. A bona fide circus exhibiting any "dangerous, exotic or endangered animals" for a period of time not to exceed a total of (10) days in any calendar year.

2. A person transporting any "dangerous, exotic or endangered animals" to a location or activity excepted herein, or transporting any "dangerous, exotic or endangered animals" directly through the Town of Mayfield;

3. Provided that, in all instances enumerated above, any "dangerous, exotic or endangered animals" are properly restrained with a view to public health, safety and welfare concerns.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES FOR OFFENSES

Any person violating any provisions of this Local Law shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars nor more that two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars, or imprisonment for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each week of violation shall be deemed a separate violation.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State.
