SINGLESTREAM RECYCLING, HOW IT WORKS

All Recyclable Items Mix Together in One Bin for Collection!

1. All recyclable items-paper, cardboard, plastic, metal and glass-need to be mixed together loosely in one bin.
2. Lids and labels can be left on recyclable containers, which should be empty and rinsed before recycling.
3. Recyclables must be placed in your designated recycling bin (a durable, lidded, plastic or metal container of your choice, 45 gallon maximum), marked with a sticker. (50lb. limit)
More than one recycling bin is OK. No private waste companies' bins allowed.
4. Do not place recyclables in plastic bags for collection (shredded paper is the only exception). No strings, no bags, no trash allowed.
5. Carboard boxes must be empty (packaging removed) and flattened/broken down before recycling.

**ONE BIN
NO BAGS
MIX ALL YOUR
RECYCLABLES TOGETHER**

**Remember the ONLY exception to the "NO BAG" RULE: SHREDDED PAPER.
Tie up in a clear plastic bag. Put the bag in with loose recyclables.**

RECYCLING DOS & DON'TS

There is a right and a wrong way to recycle. Even though well-meaning, when people put materials into recycling that don't belong, it creates problems at the processing plant and contaminates the other "good recyclables". It is important to rinse food waste from containers. Plastic bags are **NOT** allowed, with the exception of shredded paper. Improper items will be left at the curb.

Why No Plastic Bags, Light Sets, Or Rubber Hoses?

These items are referred to as tangles. They tangle up recycling machinery, which puts employees' safety at risk. It also creates long down times at the recycling plant.

Where to Recycle Bags

New York State law requires that stores collect film plastics, including: All types of plastic bags & plastic film. (Plastic film is stretchy not crinkly). Look for a box or barrel near the entrance to grocery stores, big box and discount stores. Bags should be clean & dry with **NO** food waste.

Corrugated Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard should be flattened or broken down. Put it loose in bin; lay flat on the ground and put the bin on top; or make a "cardboard package" with one box left unbroken and all other boxes flattened and stacked upright. Do **NOT** tie the cardboard in a bundle or put in a plastic bag, or you may find it left at the curb with an informational sticker attached.



Shredded Paper

The only exception to the "No Plastic Bag" rule is shredded paper, from a paper shredder, which goes in a plastic bag. Small bags of shredded paper can go in the bin. Large bags should be placed on ground next to bin.



Timing is Important

Curbside recycling should be outside by 6 am the day of pickup - or the night before. Routes vary and your pick up time may not always be the same.



These stickers will be placed on plastic bags or styrofoam, (which will be left behind) - if they are put out for curbside recycling.

Styrofoam or packing peanuts are **NOT** accepted in your recycling bin.

Finished compost is a free soil amendment and fertilizer for the garden. It is mild and won't burn plants like chemical fertilizers. By adding compost you'll improve the overall texture of your soil enabling it to retain and drain water better.

It's really easy to start composting right in your own back yard. You can purchase a compost bin from local retailers, online or make your own. For more information on how to get started, you can visit your local library or search online.

Year Round Disposal Programs

BATTERIES 		<u>Vehicle Batteries</u> can be taken to the transfer station in your municipality. There is no charge. <u>Rechargeable & Button Batteries</u> can be dropped off at the transfer station in your municipality. Alkaline household batteries should be disposed of with garbage.	
ELECTRONICS 		<u>Computers</u> , monitors, keyboards, scanners, printers, cell phones, televisions, and other electronic products can be recycled at the transfer station that serves your municipality. Small businesses and non-profits can also recycle electronics at the DSW. No charge.	
FLUORESCENT LIGHT BULBS 		<u>Fluorescent Light Bulbs</u> (tubes or CFLs) can be recycled at the DSW (see below for hours and address). Open to all county residents only (no businesses). No charge. (Incandescent light bulbs go in garbage).	
FREON 		<u>Freon-Containing units</u> (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers) must be brought to the DSW (see below). Transfer stations will not accept these appliances. \$5 charge to county residents.	
PROPANE 		<u>Propane Tanks</u> Small (one-lb) propane tanks should go in the garbage when empty. For disposal of 20-lb tanks, please call the DSW at 518-736-5501 for details.	
TEXTILES 		<u>Textile</u> drop-off boxes at all transfer stations accept: all clothing, paired shoes, purses, belts, hats, linens (no pillows), blankets, towels, drapes, stuffed animals. No charge.	
THERMOSTATS 		<u>Mercury-Containing Thermostats</u> (non-digital) can be disposed of at the DSW (in with Electronics Disposal). This program is open to all county residents, contractors, and businesses. No charge.	
TIRES 		<u>Tires</u> (off the rim) must be brought to the Department of Solid Waste (see below). (<i>Transfer stations will NOT accept tires.</i>) Open to all county residents. Fees: \$5.00 per tire up to 21"; \$13 per tire 21.5 -24.5" & tires over 24.5" or bulk tires (more than 20), charged by weight (\$350/ton).	
USED MOTOR OIL 		<u>Used Motor Oil</u> can be taken to the transfer station in your municipality. There is no charge. Used motor oil should be brought in a translucent bottle with a screw top lid, and left in a designated spot. Please do not mix with anti-freeze or other liquids.



Always look for workers before attempting to pass a recycling truck.

Remember

“Slow Down to Get Around” became law in New York State in 2016. Drivers are now required to slow down and move over for recycling and waste vehicles using their safety lights while collecting. This puts them in the same category as other hazard vehicles such as police cars or fire trucks.

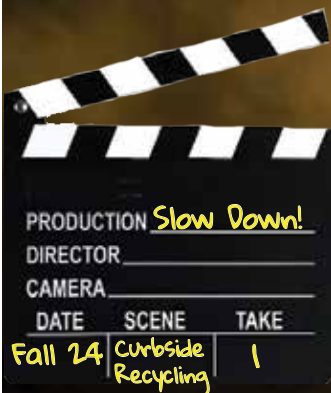

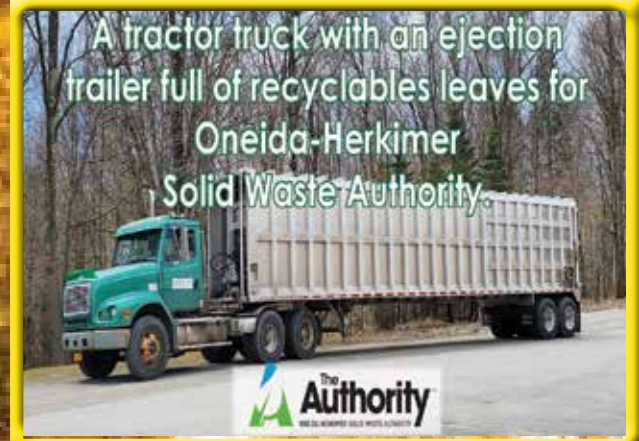

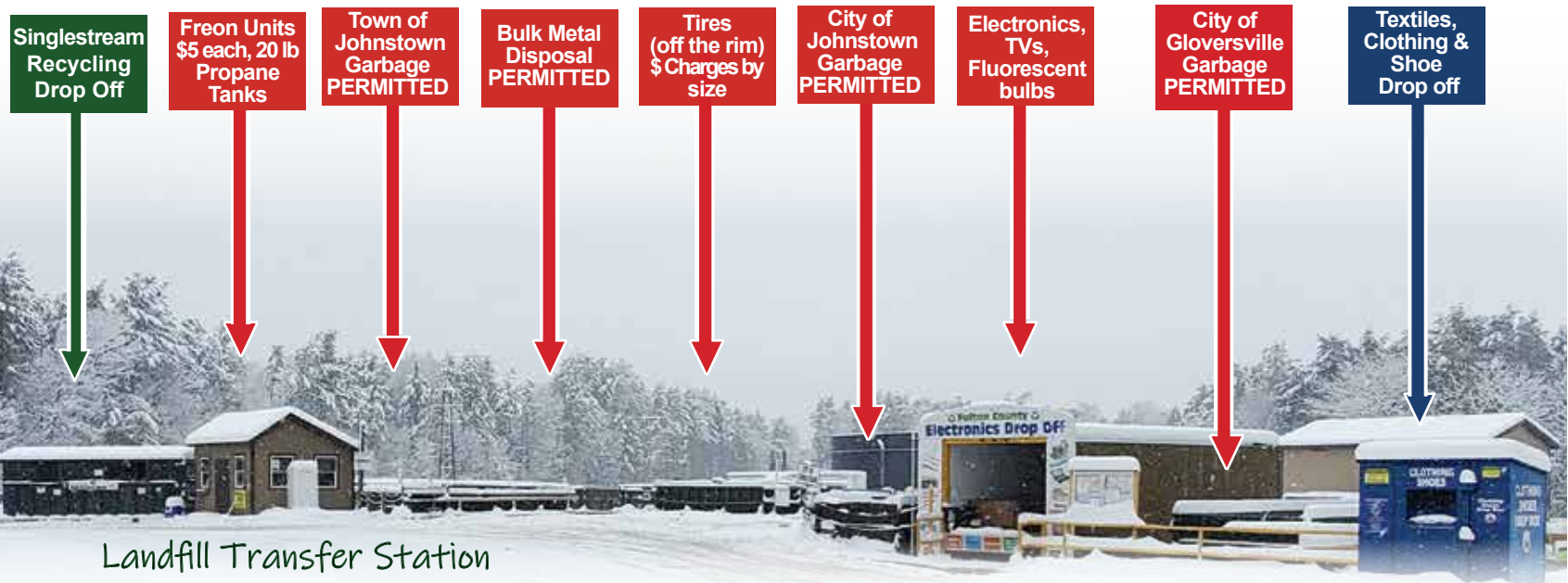
All About Transfer Stations

The DSW operates eight transfer stations throughout Fulton County. Disposal of garbage or recycling at transfer stations is by permit only (sold by municipal town or city clerks).

Residents can transport singlestream recycling to a transfer station however they want, from a large bin, to a laundry basket, or with plastic bags. However, (with the exception of shredded paper) all recycling must be deposited loose into the recycling container - so if plastic bags are used, they should be ripped open and the empty bag disposed in the garbage container provided.

Why NO Black Bags?

Fulton County Law states that residents must use white or clear bags. The reason for this is, it poses a **MAJOR SAFETY** issue to our crews in the landfill. Workers do not know what they are compacting. If you have black bags, please tear them open & empty the contents. Help Keep Our Crews Safe!



Landfill Transfer Station

A number of items can be disposed of ONLY at the Department of Solid Waste, 847 Mud Road, Johnstown, (pictured above), including tires, freon units (refrigerators, air conditioners, water coolers) and fluorescent tubes (there is a charge for tires and freon units). Textile recycling & bulk metal disposal at the Mud Road Transfer Station is for permitted residents of Gloversville, City of Johnstown and Town of Johnstown.
