Section 1. Title

This Local Law shall be known as: "A Local Law Authorizing Raffles in the Town of Mayfield".

Section 2. Definitions

Unless the context otherwise requires, the meaning of the terms used in this Local Law shall be as follows:

AUTHORIZING ORGANIZATIONS - An authorized organization as defined in Subdivision 4 of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

GAMES OF CHANCE, LIMITED TO RAFFLES - Games of chance, limited to raffles as defined by Subdivision 3-b of Section 186 of the General Municipal Law.

Section 3. Games of Chance, Limited to Raffles, Authorized

Any authorized organization may conduct games of chance, limited to raffles, within the Town of Mayfield as provided in Article 9-a Subdivision 190-a of the General Municipal Law and as provided further in this Local Law. Such games of chance shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York and with the rules and regulations adopted by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board.

Section 4. Penalties for Offenses

Any willful violation of any provision of this Local Law shall constitute and be punishable as a misdemeanor as provided in Article 9-a, Subsection 195-k of the General Municipal Law.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Local Law shall not become effective unless and until it shall have been approved by a majority of the electors voting on a proposition submitted at a general or special election held within the Town of Mayfield who are qualified to vote for officers of the Town and thereafter filed in the office of the New York State Secretary of State.


