The text of this Local Law is annexed hereto.

Section 1. Title

This Local Law will be known as the additional extension of Local Law No. 4 of the Year 2019 entitled "A Local Law Imposing a Six Month Moratorium on the Construction or Erection of a Solar Farm in the Town of Mayfield", for an additional six months.

Section 2. Intent

In the aforesaid Local Law, the Town Board of the Town of Mayfield set forth that the purpose thereof was to prevent and avoid serious detrimental health, environmental, planning conditions and development contrary to the Comprehensive Plan, which threaten the Town of Mayfield, outside the Village of Mayfield, by allowing degradation of its significant environmental resources and in order not to undermine the conscious and continuous determination by the Town to resolve and lessen such threats to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Mayfield, outside of the Village of Mayfield. It was further stated that the purpose of said Local Law was to enable the Town of Mayfield, exclusive of the Village of Mayfield, to prevent the construction or erection of a solar farm for a reasonable time pending the completion of a new or further local law regulating such construction in the Town of Mayfield. Since the Mayfield Town Board had not yet completed its investigation and research for the formulation of a new or further local law regulating such construction in the Town of Mayfield and would require additional time in order to do so, the Mayfield Town Board, on December 10, 2019 adopted Local Law No. 7 of the year 2019 extending the sixth month moratorium imposed by said Local Law No. 4 of the year 2019 for an additional six months ending July 8, 2020. On or about March 7, 2020, a "State of Emergency" was declared to be in effect in the State of New York due to a pandemic caused by the so-called Covid-19 virus, as a result of which the governmental functions of all state and local governments, including the Town of Mayfield, were seriously curtailed. Since March 7, 2020 to the present because of such curtailment, the Mayfield Town Board has not as of yet been able to complete the necessary investigation and research for the formulation of a new or further local law regulating the construction or erection of a solar farm in the Town of Mayfield, and will require additional time in order to do so.

Section 3. Moratorium Extended

Local Law No. 4 of the year 2019 imposing a six month moratorium on the construction or erection of a solar farm in the Town of Mayfield shall be and the same is hereby extended for an additional period of six (6) months, commencing July 8, 2020 and ending January 7, 2021. Except as modified hereby or inconsistent herewith, all of the provisions, terms and conditions contained in said Local Law No. 4 of the year 2019, and in said Local Law No. 7 of the year 2019, shall be and are hereby continued in full force and effect, and are also hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
